

Job Title: PICU Ambulance Driver

Location: Oxford

Remuneration: £17,500

Job Description

You will be responsible for driving an Ambulance and transferring sick/injured ambulatory paediatric patients from hospital to hospital throughout Oxford and the Home Counties which will also include London area. You will be accompanied by a team of medics who will take care of the patients needs.

The job purpose is to provide and maintain a caring environment for emergency and non emergency patients and provide a transport service as appropriate for the needs of the patient.

Your principle responsibilities include:

- Preparing and driving emergency vehicle
- Administering first aid such as bandaging, splinting and administering oxygen
- Place patients on stretchers and load into ambulances, usually with assistance from crew member
- Remove and replace soiled linens and equipment in order to maintain sanitary conditions
- Replace supplies and disposable items in vehicles
- Report facts concerning accidents or emergencies to hospital personnel or law enforcement officers
- Lifting and moving patients under emergency / non-emergency conditions, using appropriate equipment where necessary
- Reporting defects and deficiencies of the vehicles and equipment, and replace all items of vehicle inventory used
- Preparation emergency /non-emergency equipment for use
- Providing social care in emergency / non-emergency situations including situations involving death
- Observing and complying with the companies Health and Safety policies and procedures
- Ensure the health and safety of yourself and others affected by all ambulance activities
- Complete all records and returns properly and promptly
- Perform cardio-pulmonary resuscitation as per protocol when required
- Provide care to patients with injuries / illness using medical skills
- Provide assistance in emergency situations
- Assess and prioritise medical requirements
- Carry out risk assessments at all incidents to assess hazards, then implement safe systems of work and reduce risks to yourself, patients and other persons involved
- To be responsible for adhering to the companies security policy whilst using or in the proximity of any company computer equipment

You must work within the confines of the said and stated Standard Operating Procedures (SOPs). You must ensure that the above responsibilities are met and such other duties and tasks as are allocated to you at the discretion of the Company that are within your capabilities and within the scope of your post. The Company reserves the right to review your performance on a regular basis. You will unless prevented by ill health devote the whole of your working time attention and abilities to the business of the Company.

The shift will be a 12 hour day 4 days on and 4 days off.
